All of the south half (1/2) of the West half (1/2) of the North west Quarter (1/4) of Section eight (8) township twelve (12) North; range seven (7) West, 1.M. except one block of ground in the Southeast part of said tract one hundred fifty (150) feet by two hundred forty seven (247) feet in area, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South boundary line of said tract thirty three (33) feet West of the Southeast Corner of said tract, running thence due West from said point a distance of one hundred fifty (150) feet along the South boundary line of said tract, thence due North a distance of 247 ft, thence due East a distance of 150 ft, thence due South a distance of 247 ft, to the point of beginning.

And said Harden Realty Company, for value received hereby dedicates all streets, alleys, and public grounds as shown on said Map, to the public use forever.

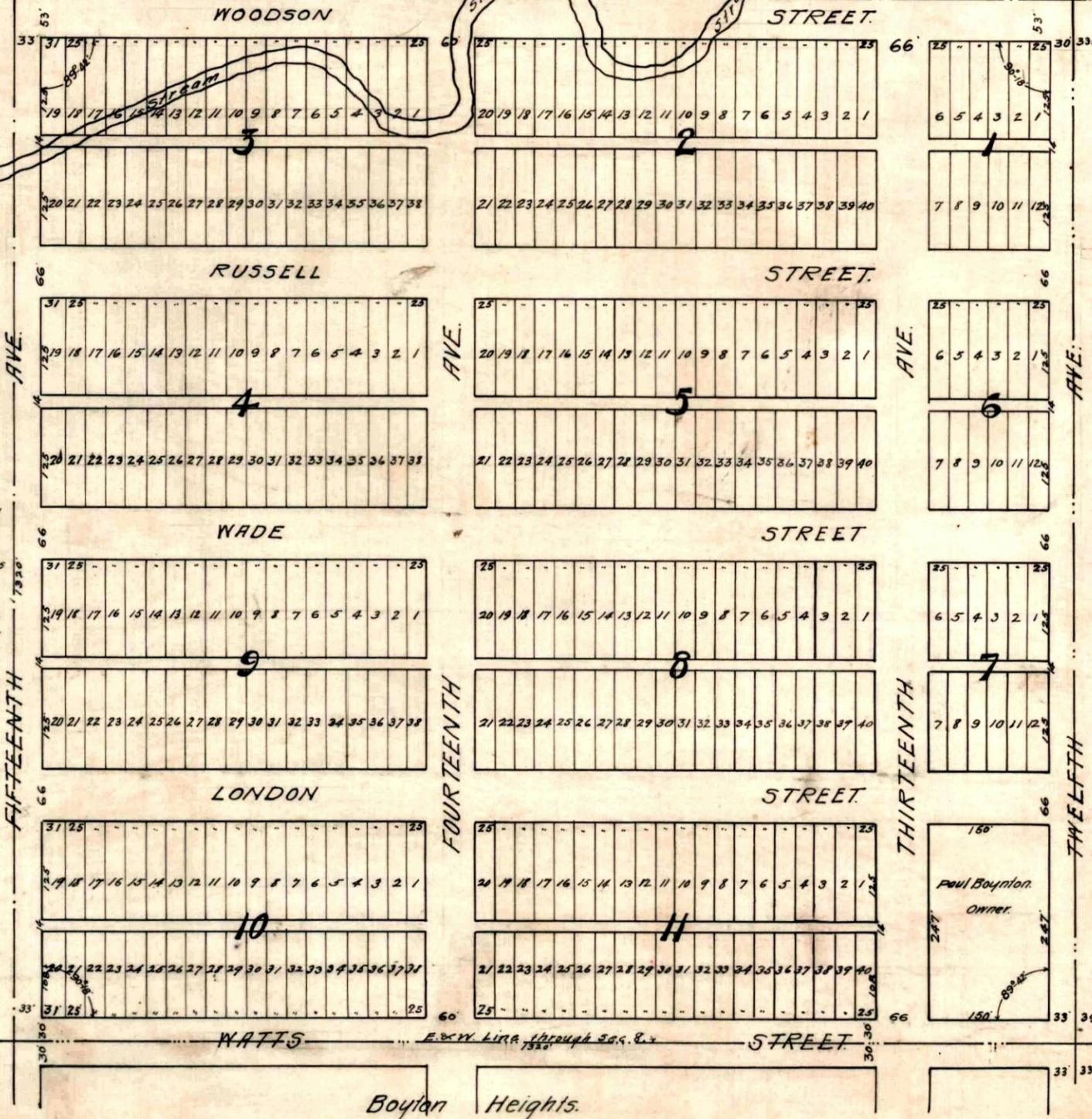
