

# Lewis Addition to Calumet O. T.

I, C. C. Brown, a practical surveyor, hereby certify that I have surveyed and plotted the annexed plat of Lewis Addition to Calumet into lots, blocks, streets and alleys, said Lewis Addition is located east and south of Calumet and adjoining as shown on annexed plat in the south west quarter section thirteen (13) in Twp. 13 N. R. 15 W. of range nine (9) 3d. 2m. in Canadian County O. T., containing two and eight hundredths (2.08) acres. The exterior boundaries of the said Addition are of the distances marked upon said plat, all lots, blocks, streets and alleys are of the dimensions marked upon said plat. A 2" x 2" yellow pine stake being driven at the corners of each block and half blocks.

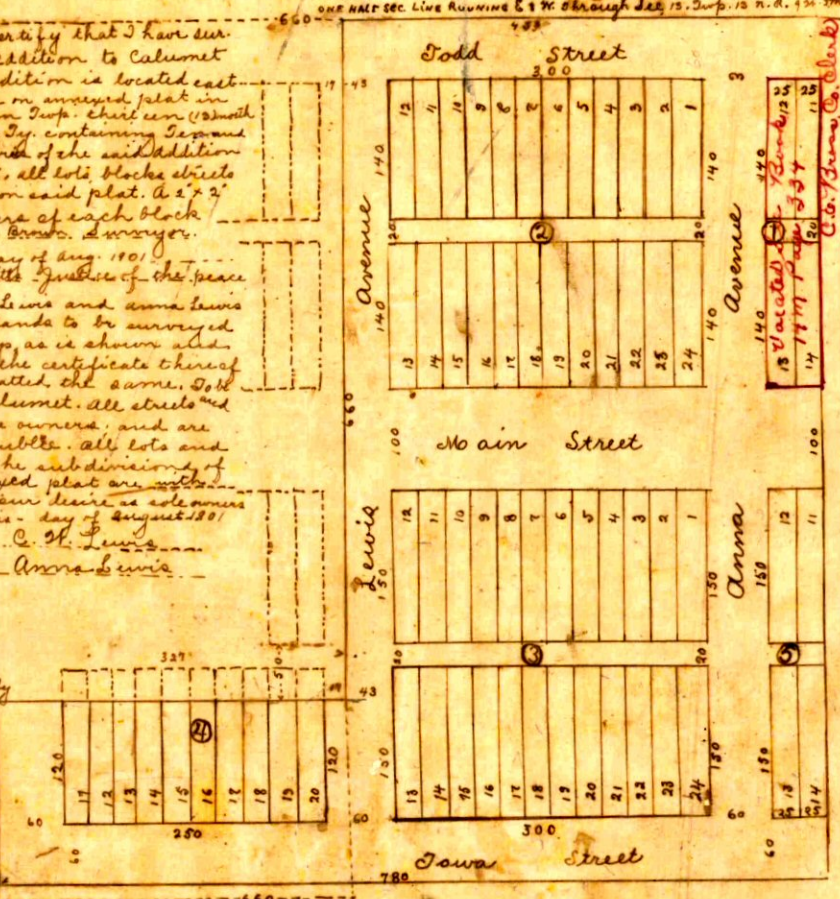
Subscribed and sworn to before me this 17 day of Aug. 1901.
