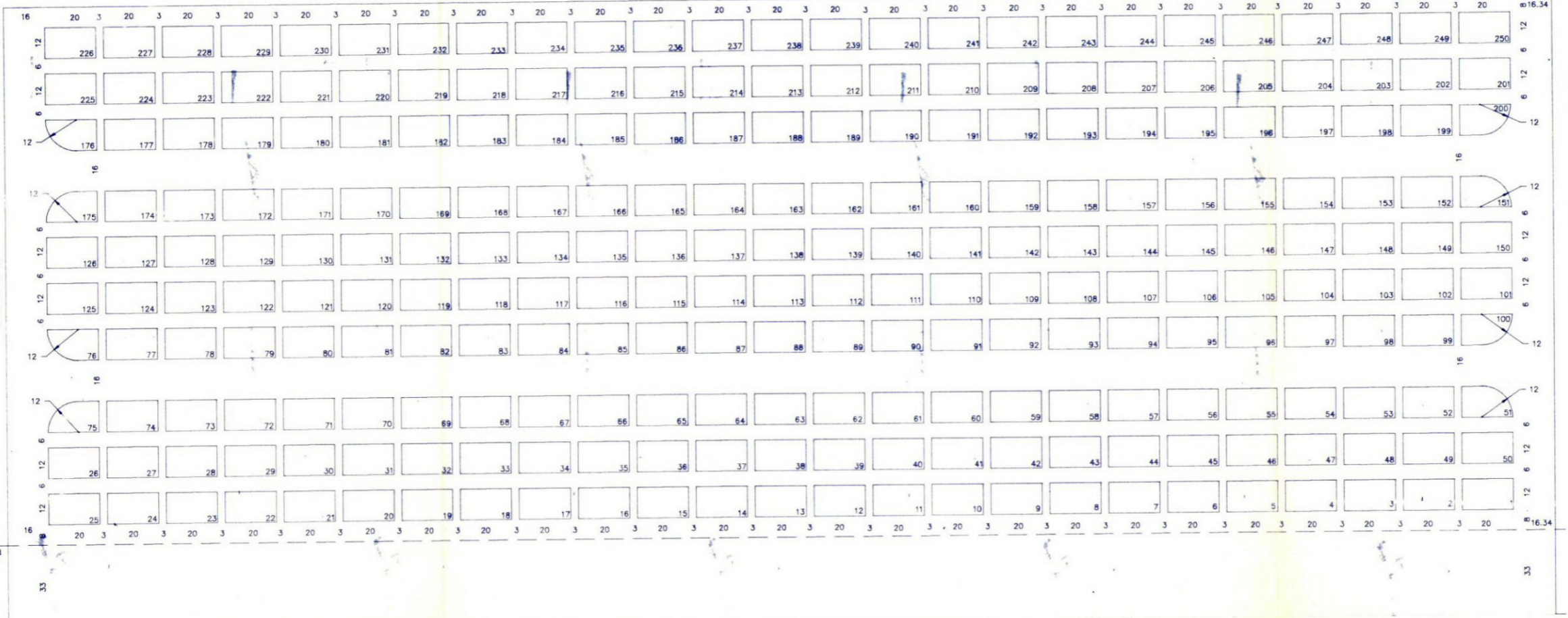
**OWNERS CERTIFICATE AND DEDICATION**  
This instrument witnesseth that the Mathewson Cemetery Association through its boardmembers, to wit: O.B. Stover, Chairman, Herman Stover, James Tallant, Irene Ratcliff, Trustee, and Beulah Jech, Sec'y-Treasurer do hereby certify that it is the owner in fee simple of the following described tract of land: A tract of land in the East one-half (E 1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4), Section Twenty-three (23), Township Fourteen North (T14N), Range Six West (R6W) of the Indian Meridian, Canadian County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Section corner for sections 23, 24, 25 and 26, thence N 0° 12' 40" W between sections 23 and 24 a distance of 1388.6 feet to the point of beginning, thence S 0° 12' 40" E along the section line a distance of 604.34 feet, thence N 89° 58' 00" W a distance of 243.0 feet, thence N 0° 12' 40" W a distance of 604.34 feet, thence S 89° 58' 00" E a distance of 243.0 feet to the point and place of beginning, containing 3.371 acres more or less. We also certify that we have caused the same to be surveyed and subdivided into lots and alleys for cemetery purposes, and hereby dedicate the alleys to the use of the public, for such use as is customary and generally in use by cemetery associations for the government of said Cemetery, and the Plat here to attached is a true and correct delineation of said survey. Iron pins have been set in the Mathewson Cemetery West at each lot corner. The lot sizes are 12 feet East to West and 20 feet North to South and these lots are as shown on the Plat.

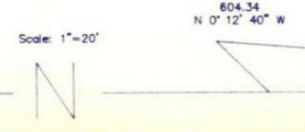
