Description of Townsite.

Beginning at the southwest corner of section 33 township 14 north, range 5 west; thence east along south line of said section 1320 ft.; thence north 1625 ft.; thence west 1320 ft. to the west line of said section 33; thence north along said section line 774 ft. to a point 253 1/2 ft. south of the northeast corner of southeast quarter section 33 township and range as aforesaid; thence west 2580 ft. to a point which is 23 1/2 ft. south and 57 1/2 ft. east of the northwest corner of said southeast quarter section; thence south 2616 3/4 ft. to the south line of said quarter section of a point 57 ft. east of the southwest corner thereof; thence east along said south line 2580 ft. to the place of beginning.

The undersigned, C. C. Nelson and H. T. Smith, hereby certify that they are the owners, as trustees of an expressed trust, of the land the exterior lines of which are marked on this plat; that they caused the same to be surveyed into lots, blocks, streets, avenues and alleys, and this plat thereof to be made under the name of the Town of Piedmont in the County of Canadian and Territory of Oklahoma by H. A. Gernung, Engineer & Surveyor, and caused a base line to be established along the main street of said town as required by Section 3, Article 3, Chapter 15, of the Statutes of 1893 of said Territory; that all the streets, avenues and alleys of the said town are marked, noted and shown on this plat, and are hereby dedicated to the public for public use as streets, avenues and alleys.

And the said H. A. Gernung, Engineer and Surveyor, hereby certifies that he surveyed such portions of the southeast quarter of section 32 and of the southwest quarter of section 33, in township 14 north, range 5 west, in the said county, as is shown on this plat, into lots, blocks, streets, avenues and alleys, as shown hereon, and this plat thereof to be made describing and setting forth all the streets, avenues, alleys, or other public grounds, and all lots and blocks, within said town of Piedmont, giving names, widths, courses, boundaries and extent of all such streets, avenues and alleys, and the said lots and blocks to be numbered in progressive numbers and the precise width and length thereof to be stated on this plat, and established the above said base line in the place and the manner required by said statutes.
