Description of Townsite
Beginning at the north west corner of the northeast quarter of section 26 township 13 north, range 6 west; thence east on north line of said quarter section 26 600 ft. to the northeast corner thereof; thence south on the east line of said quarter section 1023 ft. thence west 1000 ft. to a point which is 100 ft. at right angles and inwardly from the center line of the St. Louis, El Reno & Western Railway as now located across said quarter section; thence Street W (magnetic bearing) parallel to and 100 ft. from said center line 1023 ft. thence Street E (magnetic bearing) set to a point set distant at right angles from said center line 300 ft. (magnetic bearing) parallel to and set from said center line 178 ft. to the west line of said quarter section; thence north on said west line 1800 ft. to the place of beginning.
