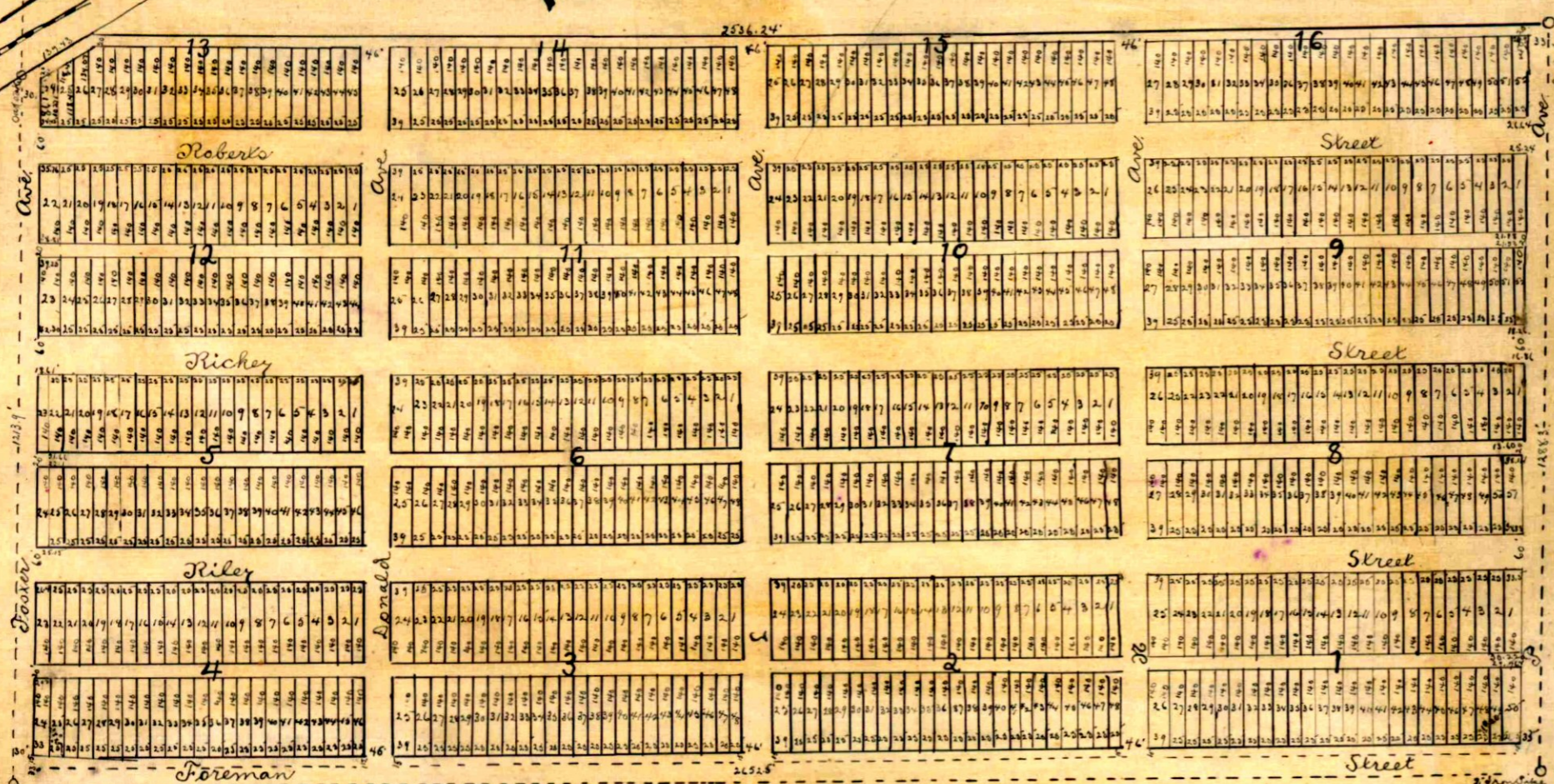


RILEY ADDITION
