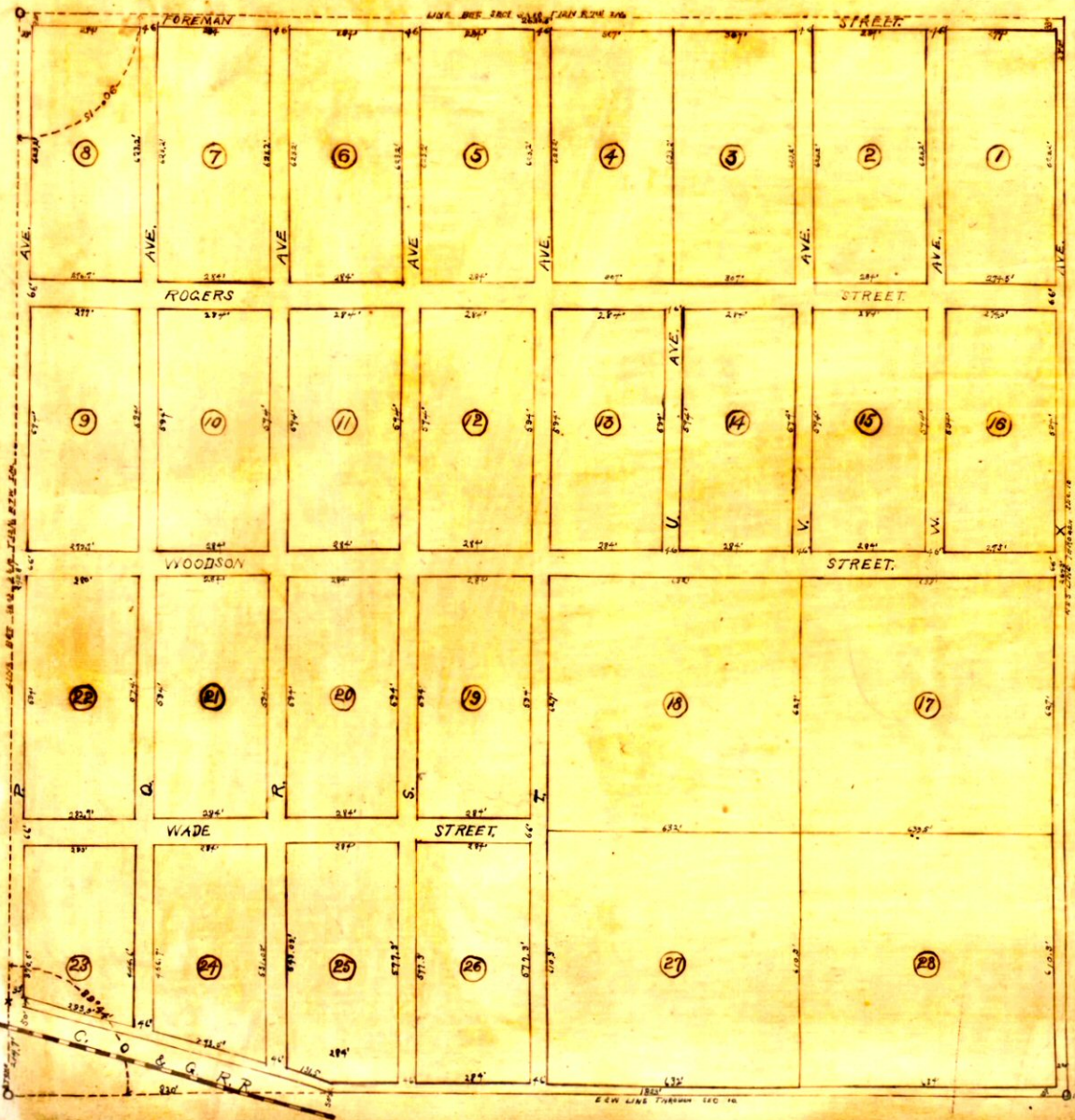


RIVERSIDE ADDITION.
