Description

Being lots 1 and 2 in fractional Section 8 Township 12 north Range 7 west Indian Meridian, the same being the north half of Homestead of Thompson as shown by the records of Kingfisher Land Office, this day of July, 1890.

Know all men by these presents that James Thompson Thompson of Fourth County Oklahoma Territory who is entitled to the benefit of the Homestead laws of the United States having applied for the purchase of the land herein described to the Secretary of the Interior to purchase said land for Townsite Purposes under section 22 of an act to provide a Temporary Government for the Territory of Oklahoma of a date May 2nd 1890. Said land being described as follows to wit: Being lots 1 and 2 in fractional Section 8 Township 12 north Range 7 west Indian Meridian the same being required for Townsite Purposes. This map marked "Thompson Part of El Reno" represents said described land as subdivided into lots and blocks, Streets, avenues, and alleys, all streets, avenues, and alleys are hereby dedicated for public purposes.

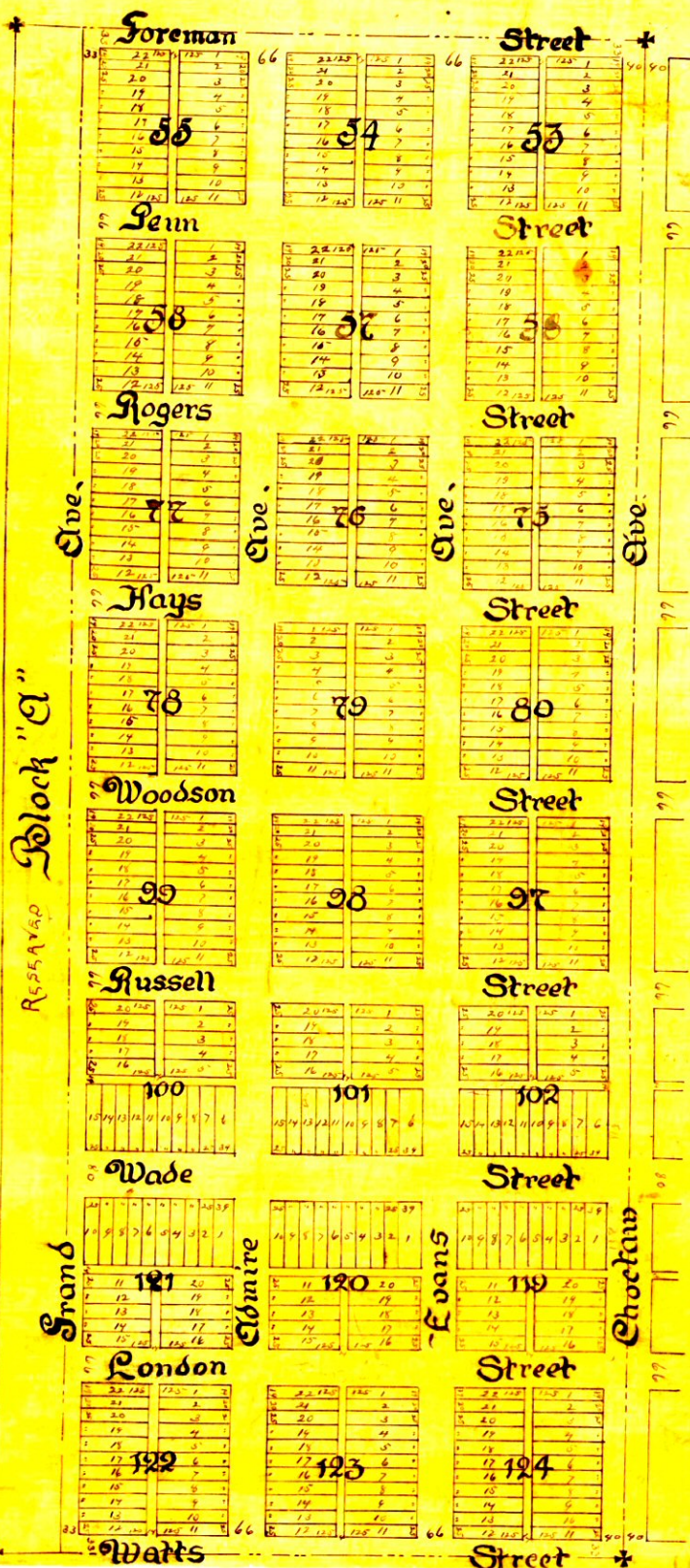
