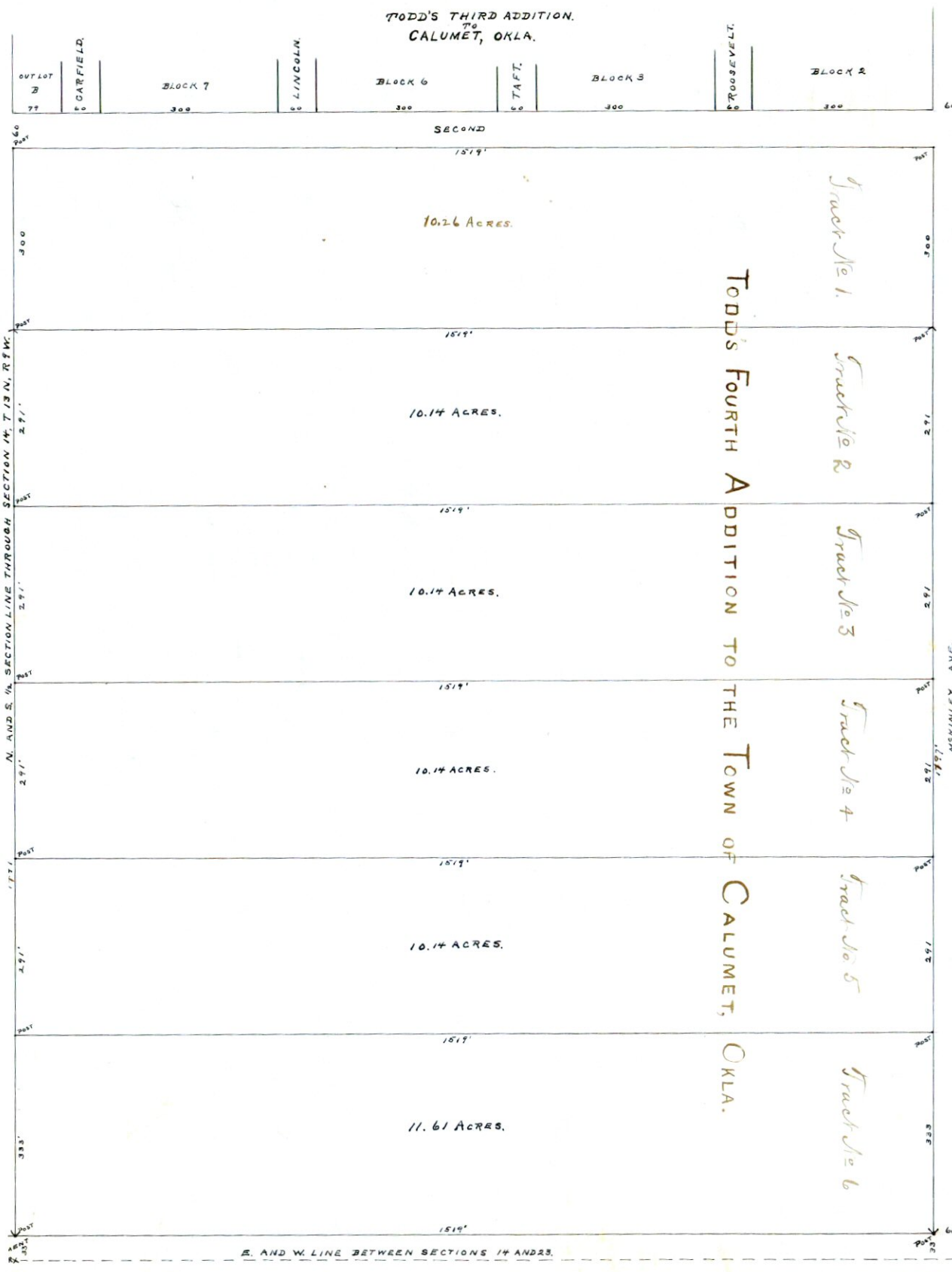


TODD'S THIRD ADDITION.
