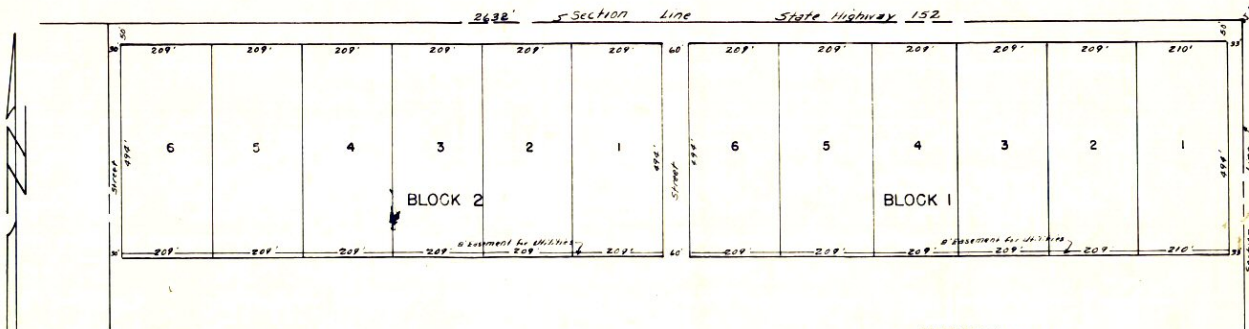

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 32, T-11-N, R-5-W, thence North 544 feet, thence West 2632 feet, thence North 544 feet, thence East 2632 feet to the point of beginning.
